Boys Volleyball Tryouts

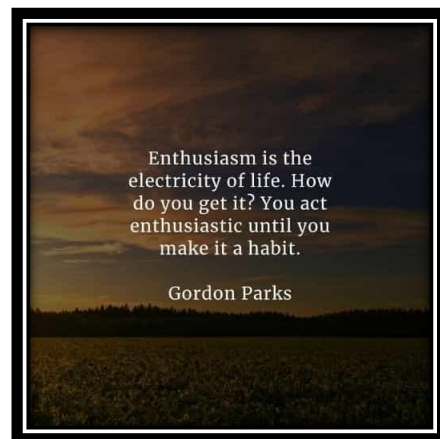

What is Diwali?

Diwali, also known as Deepavali, is often referred to as the Festival of Lights. It is one of India's biggest and most important holidays of the year. It's also the most important event in the [Hindu](#) calendar. The event is celebrated by more than a billion people across several religions including Hinduism, Jainism, and Sikhism.

The significance behind Diwali is about light overcoming darkness, good overcoming evil, and wise thoughts overcoming ignorance. It's also about celebrating the new year and hope for new beginnings.



Diwali takes place on the 15th day of the Hindu month Kartika. This is the Amavasya (or new moon) in the Hindu lunar calendar. However, since the lunar calendar does not mirror the Gregorian calendar, the date changes annually. Diwali is usually celebrated between October and November.
