- Comprehension: showing the understanding of the goals of the projects

- 3. Craftsmanship: If it's not a right angle, it's a wrong angle.

Because of the high prices of perishable materials, students are asked to pay a material fee donation of \$20.00 for the year. This donation will provide sufficient access to supplies for the projects.

This course meets UC/CSU (F) and District graduation requirements for VAPA credit. This second-year course builds and expands the experiences of Art I and Design. Students will continue to use their drawing and painting skills to create original works of art in a variety of traditional and non-traditional materials and techniques based on demonstrations, lectures, and individual research and planning. Students will begin to explore and develop personal goals

and philosophies that are reflected in their portfolios. Students will become familiar with major art movements that add to their understanding of different cultures, artists, and historical periods. Students will continue to apply what they have learned for individual growth and problem-solving, and they will continue to practice time management and meeting deadlines. Writing assignments include artistic research, gallery reports, and art criticisms. Material fees and some supplies are required.
